

IMPORTANCE OF HAWAII'S HARBORS

- 80% of all goods used in Hawaii are imported.
- 98.6% of the goods are brought in through the commercial harbors system.
- Maritime activities: cargo; cruise; commercial fishing; ship building and repairs; marine research; military support ops.





KAPALAMA CONTAINER TERMINAL – \$500M

HAWAII SEA LEVEL RISE VULNERABILITY AND ADAPTATION REPORT






SEA LEVEL CHANGE – INFRASTRUCTURE MOD

SEA LEVEL CHANGE – ADPAPTATION STRATEGIES

- Physical modifications to harbors infrastructure
 - incremental elevation of piers and bulkheads
 - full elevation with mechanical enhancements
 - retreat from shoreline; construct lock & dam that services new inland harbor
- Mechanical enhancements
 - custom ramps, gantry cranes, or cargo elevators
- Vessel modifications
 - cranes on barges
 - vessel platform lifts
 - vessel ballast adjustments

SEA LEVEL CHANGE – RISK VS COST

- Incremental changes are lower costs upfront but costly over time with multiple planning, design, and construction projects.
- Incremental changes cause numerous disruptions to operations over time.
- Full modifications have higher upfront costs but may cause least disruptions to operations.
- Full modifications will require modifications to vessels and barges.
- Where is the funding coming from? Federal infrastructure investments?

SHORELINE PROTECTION

- DLNR responsible for shoreline management, resource management, parks, and recreational harbors.
- DOT-HARBORS responsible for commercial harbors.
- DOT-HIGHWAYS responsible for State highways.
- COUNTIES responsible for local roads and county parks.


