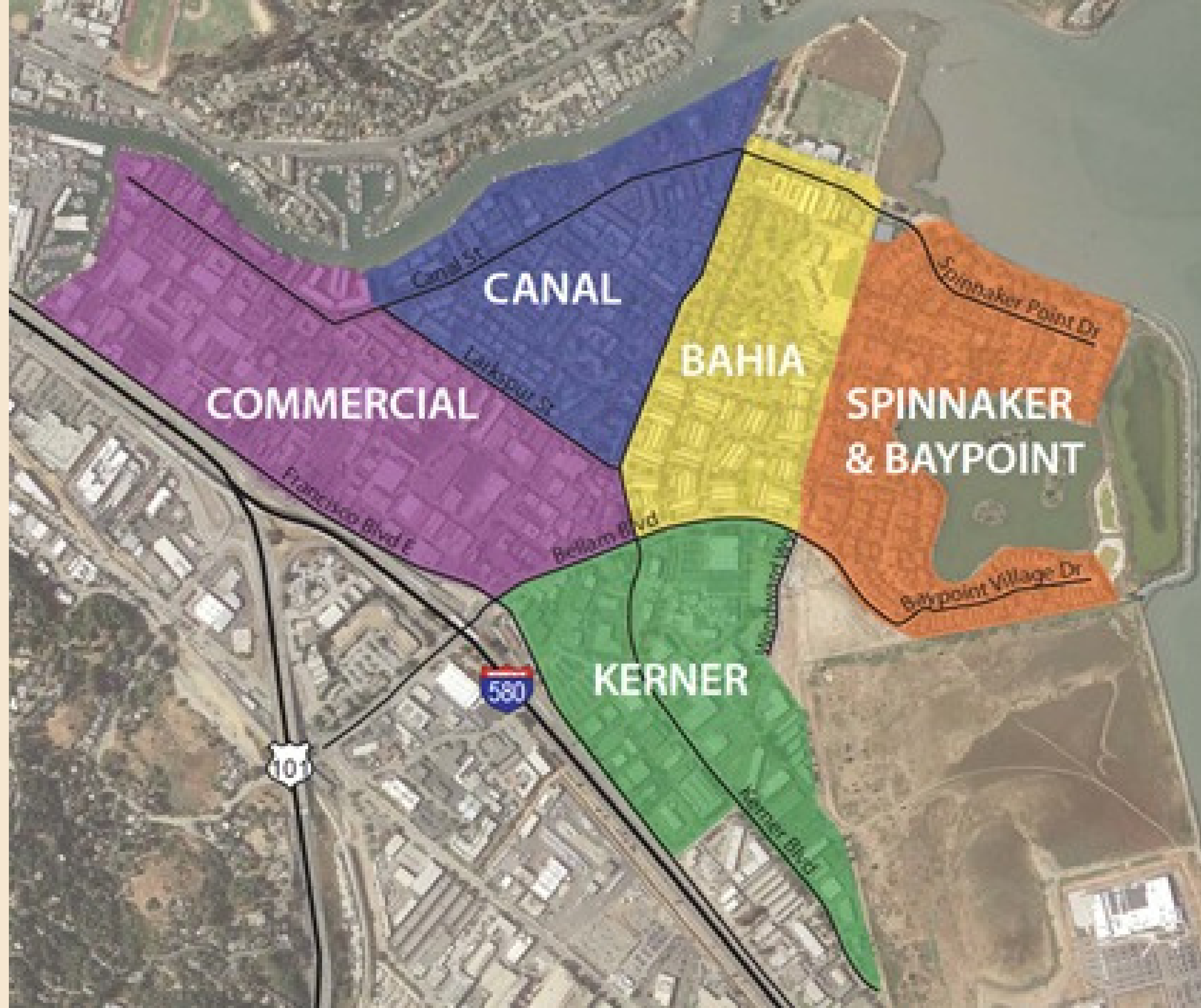
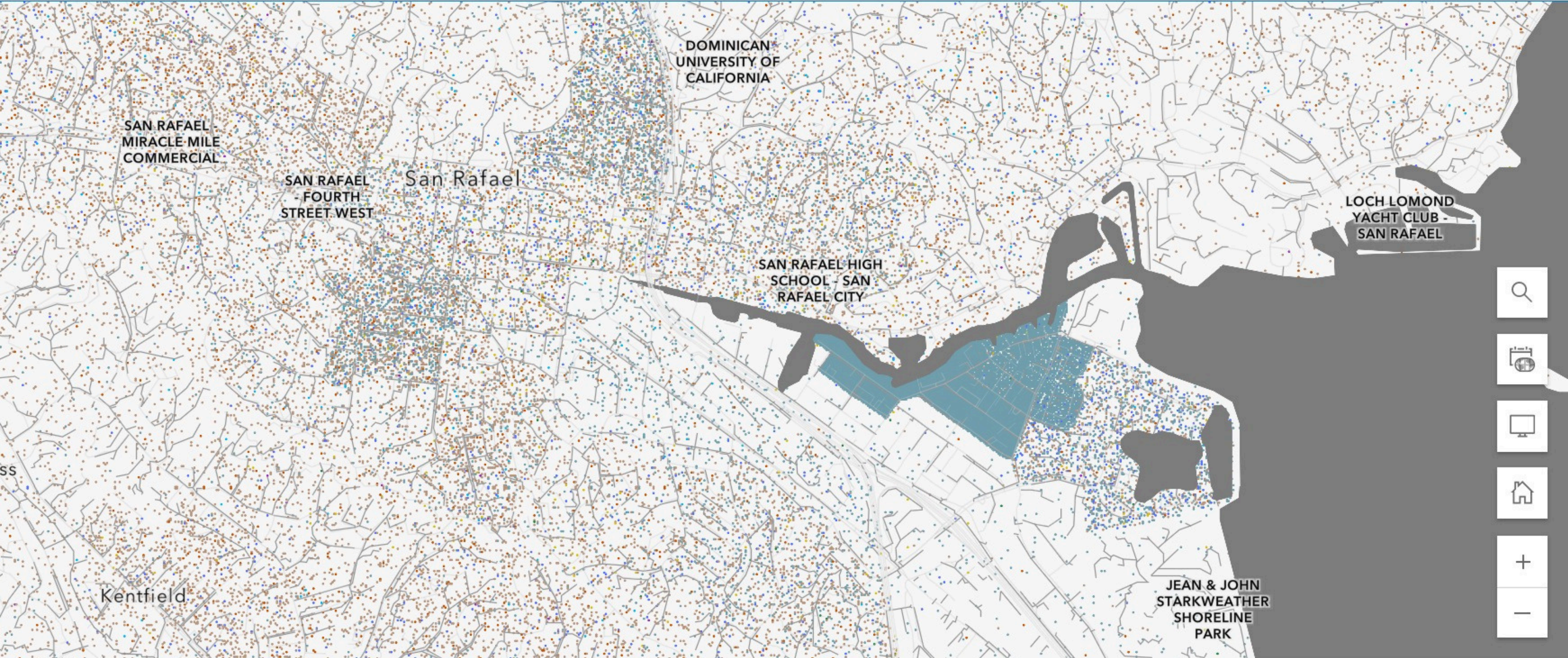


Sea Level Rise in San Rafael
